It is hereby notified to all concerned that, in accordance with the Government order as outlined in G.O. No. 354-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14, dated 02.06.2023, and subsequently supported by the circular issued by the Undergraduate Council (UG Council) of NBU under circular no. 144/UG-23, dated 19.06.2023, the **second round of online application submissions** for enrollment into the **4-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM** offering a **SINGLE MAJOR** in **B.A. / B.Sc.**, adhering to the **New Curriculum and Credit Framework** for the academic session 2023-2024 at A.P.C. Roy Govt. **Note:**

- As per Govt. Order No. 1084(20)-Edn (U)/EH/1U-89/13 dated 07.12.2018 of Government of West Bengal, **Persons With Disabilities (PWD) will enjoy a 5% reservation in each of the categories**, i.e., in SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B and in the Unreserved or General category, and such candidates, if available, shall be placed towards the top of the list prepared for each category of students. For such candidate's minimum **disability at least 40%** will be considered.
- **SC/ST/OBC** candidates from states outside West Bengal are **NOT ENTITLED** to seek any reservations benefits as per West Bengal Govt. Rule (vide G.O. No. ED-340/2012). These candidates should apply as General Category candidates, provided they meet the eligibility criteria set for the General Category.
- As per Govt. Order No. 325-PAR(AR)/3P-1,/2019 dated 9th July, 2019, issued by the Personnel & Administrative Reforms Department (Administrative Reforms Cell), Government of West Bengal candidates belonging to **Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs)** who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs shall get **10% reservation** for admission in Educational Institutions in West Bengal. EWS Certificate is valid for the financial year of issuance of certificate.

**Note: Please note that all eligible candidates will be called for provisional admission. However, paying the Provisional Admission fee will not ensure admission to the college. The number of candidates to be effectively admitted will depend on the availability of subject-wise and category-wise vacancies, as well as the merit position of the candidate. Those who pay the Provisional Admission fee but cannot be accommodated due to unavailability of vacancies will be treated as waitlisted candidates. If fresh vacancies occur thereafter due to admission cancellations, candidates will be notified accordingly for Admission Confirmation (a confirmation message will be sent to their registered mobile number) from the pool of Waitlisted Candidates. Remaining waitlisted candidates who are not confirmed will be refunded the Provisional Admission Fee later. After the refund, the candidature of refunded candidate/candidates will be canceled permanently.**
